The long awaited Golf Pro Shop has arrived. For those of you who have been down to the clubhouse on a busy summer day you know how difficult it is to operate a restaurant and golf check in from the limited space available in the clubhouse. Thanks to the recommendation from the Golf Committee and help from residents Darren and Steve Bach we have been able to secure a trailer that will be used for golf check-in and To Go orders. The trailer is positioned off of hole #1 and will also help us to coordinate between the check-in counter and the starters to ensure that patrons have checked in before teeing off. There will be a monthly fee of about \$450 for the rental of the trailer which is well below market value and most of which will likely be recouped by reduction in no shows because of increased tracking capabilities with the non-paying customers. The trailer will be used seasonally and will not be staffed during slower periods of the year. If you have not already done so, come on down and check it out. Happy Golfing!

LONG TERM MAINTENANCE REPORT



- Kalio Restoration mobilized on August 12 to commence siding restoration on three buildings. They will also be commencing location specific repairs to diverters, flashings and gutters.
- Crush completed cleaning, flushing and inspecting both sanitary and storm drain systems. They also excavated the water main line at the lowest point on the property to examine the pipe for pitting which will determine the condition of the pipeline.
- Roof and gutter cleaning and moss removal Most removal has been completed on the quads and their garages. Cleaning and removal has now started on the east side Townhomes.
- Targeted painting and caulking on some condos and townhomes to commence August 19.
- Power assessment has been completed by the engineering professional. LTMC has received the report and it is currently under review.
- Curbs, walkways and parking blocks still under review by the LTMC and Council.

AROUND NICO WYND

From working on broken hanging branches, weeding, bark mulching, pruning and removing shrubs, plants and trees it's been a busy summer for our grounds crew! It is wasp season and there are nests as large as basketballs around the Strata grounds. Do not attempt to treat these nests as these wasps have a very nasty sting. Contact Craig at craig@nicowynd.bc.ca to have them treated. A number of tree snags have been removed for safety purpose behind #3699. There is also a large leaning cedar tree which overhangs the roadway on Crescent Road that needs to be removed.

EAGLE TREE UPDATE

Nico Wynd has been fortunate to work with David Hancock (Biologist) who has specialized in eagles over many years. He has been ongoingly evaluating and informing us as to the eagles' safety given the health of the tree in which they have their current nest site. For any residents who may not be aware, the nest is in the Northeast corner of Nico Wynd. Just ask anyone in the area to point it out to you! Currently, David has put together a proposal to try to relocate the eagles' nest this September while the eagles reside in Brackendale, BC during the Fall when the salmon arrive in the rivers to spawn. Timing is everything and this is a complex process which involves Wildlife Canada. It also involves considerable costs. The complexity, costs and multiple variables of this undertaking must all be evaluated and are before our Council at this time. You will be kept informed as decisions are arrived at. In the meantime, as Nico Wynd residents we are very fortunate to have this pair of eagles sharing our beautiful location and us being able to be awed and enjoy their presence!
